Circular to operating banks in the Kingdome

Subject: The Electronic Platform for Data Gathering and Analysis

After greetings,

In light of the Central Bank of Jordan's efforts to build a comprehensive and accurate central database that enables the understanding of electronic payment tools, channels, and systems used in executing financial transactions, leading to a comprehensive overview of the components of the national payment system in the Kingdom and its connection with the economy, and the Central Bank's development of the electronic platform system for data gathering and analysis on the live environment of the Central Bank, we would like to inform you of the following:

- 1- Amending item (3) of our circular No. 26/4/5920 dated 27/05/2020 regarding data related to electronic payment systems, channels, and instruments to read as follows: "Providing the Central Bank with the required data according to the frequency specified for each form and within the period specified in Appendix No. (1) of this circular and each form separately through the electronic platform for data gathering and analysis." This amendment will be effective from January 2024 for monthly reports and the first quarter of 2024 for quarterly reports.

2- Amending item (2) of our circular No. 26/4/6195 dated 04/06/2020 regarding financial transfers to read as follows: “Providing the Central Bank with the required data on a monthly and individual basis, with the form being sent through the electronic platform for data gathering and analysis.” This amendment will be effective from January 2024.

With an emphasis on the commitment to provide us with the data forms for electronic payment systems, channels, and tools for the year 2023 in accordance with the provisions of our circular No. 26/4/5920 dated 27/05/2020, in addition to uploading them to the electronic platform for data gathering and analysis before the end of the first quarter of 2024.
