them not meeting the requirements of the Central Bank and to emphasize the

importance of adhering to the above circular in accordance with the

requirements of the Central Bank to ensure providing better management for

the continuity of the work of the payment, clearing and settlement systems

referred to in the circular during the research, taking into account the

increased systemic importance of these systems as a result of increasing the

volume and quality of their operations and relying on them as a main channel

in creating and executing payment and transfer orders in the Kingdom, in

addition to achieving immediate recovery of operations and fulfilling the

obligations of the systems and their participants, and service recipients, in

order to create a safe and efficient national payment system, and therefore I

emphasize the following:

1. Examine and ensure the continuity of the systems mentioned in our

circular above from the alternative location of your bank to ensure the

continuity of the operation of these systems and your ability to reach the

Central Bank from your disaster recovery site no later than 1/10/2017.

2. Providing the Central Bank with a report from the external auditor

confirming the reliability of the business continuity plan for critical

services mentioned in our circular above, and the results of its

examination, and recommendations related thereto, no later than the end of

the first quarter of 2018.

3. Providing the Central Bank with the names, phone numbers and e-mails of

Bank regarding business continuity of payment, clearing, and settlement

system, and communication lines with the closed network of the Central

Bank and any updates that occur directly to it.
